Meeting of the 129th BOD HESCO was held on Saturday, 1st April, 2017 at 11:00 am in the Committee Room, HESCO Power Wing Colony Hussainabad, Hyderabad, List of participants is attached at (Annexure-I).

The meeting started with the recitation of verses from the Holy Qura'an. The Company Secretary extended warm welcome to the participants of meeting.

Before the meeting Company Secretary informed that Mr. Mohammad Sohail Khan Rajput and Mr. Shafique Ahmed Mahesar, H'able Directors BOD HESCO could not attend the meeting due hearing at Honorable Court.

After accepting the leave, Company Secretary presented the approved agenda items one by one to the Board for discussion and consideration.

Board appreciated that the progress is gradually increasing but they were concerned that targets were not achieved as per KPI. Board directed SEs operation to accelerate their efficiency and achieve the targets already given to them. Board also desired to conduct the monthly progress review meeting regularly with all Operation Circles in every Board meetings.

During meeting, SEs also informed that due to shortage of staff and some unwilling workers the work of operation sub divisions badly suffers. SEs also demanded the suitable vehicles for the subdivisions. Board suggested CEO HESCO to look into the matter and inform the board about shortage of vehicles as well as human resource and inquired the action taken against non-performing workers in next BOD meeting.

SE Nawabshah also presented a new system in which the consumer electric meter become totally secure in the box and could be controlled via circuit breaker result of which the load of 11 kV feeder also decreased. The Board member appreciated the proposal and suggested that agenda item along with its presentation may be given in next Board meeting to decide matter in the best interest of company.
